Updated Info on the Air Force Academy & AC-130J Tour

Your Board of Directors is still working through some unexpected situations, trying to resolve issues to make for a smooth running tour day. First, we were surprised that no restaurant nearby is available to quickly provide lunch to 80+ people. Then, looking at the AFA facilities, all the "on-site" locations providing lunch services were already booked solid. Therefore, we will provide a \$15 "box" lunch from Chick-Fil-A, at the comfortable AFA Family Campgrounds. Lots of tables under cover & clean restrooms are available. The box contains a chicken sandwich, waffle fries, & a cookie. Soft drinks & water are available. A vegi box will be available for those who registered for vegi meals. Second, the Academy is undergoing a huge building project next to the SEA Pavilion. The parking lot is excavated, & the walking path to the Pavilion is closed. Yes, there is access to the Pavilion, but it may involve a short staircase through the adjacent Academy of Graduates building or a walk down a driveway to get past the pathway closure. Lastly, with global tensions getting hotter, the 16th SOS may not be able to send an AC-130J Ghostrider to Colorado Springs. This will be addressed before the tour &, if necessary, the schedule will be adjusted.

Handicap accessibility on train

The Royal Gorge Railroad has informed us our group is in Coach class. There is a lift to help those in a wheelchair get onto the Coach class car. In each car there is 1 wheelchair designated area. They have reserved one for Dale. In the Deluxe car there is a bathroom with handicap accessibility including grab bars. Because you may not be able to get a wheelchair through the graveled parking lot, they have a golf cart for the disabled. Wheelchairs can also be placed on the golf cart.
